COVID-19 School Update

Staff testing

We will begin the routine testing of staff this week. All staff attending school will take Covid-19 LFD tests twice weekly. This is an added layer to our risk assessment and the aim is to slow asymptomatic transmission of the disease. We will of course, inform parents in cases where a bubble may need to close.

Remote Learning

As we move into week 4 of home learning, you may notice children getting tired and giving up on work more easily. This is completely normal! Just encourage them as much as possible and sign up to the live teaching sessions where teachers will explain tasks and provide the motivation necessary to complete learning.

Our remote learning offer is available on the school website under 'Curriculum' and 'Home Learning.' We will continue to make improvements to this offer and develop new ways to engage children in learning.
