Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you regarding procedures for notification of self-isolation over the half term break, following Government guidance.

Schools have been asked to continue contact tracing until Thursday 27 May 2021. This means that we may potentially have to contact families if there has been a positive case in their child's bubble prior to the end of term. In light of the aforementioned guidance, I have implemented the following procedures, which we ask parents to follow if their child displays symptoms and has a test.

- a) If a child develops the symptoms from **Monday 24 May**, you **should not** contact school and contact NHS Track and Trace.
- b) If a child displays symptoms of Covid-19, within 48 hours of being at school you should arrange a test and contact school via the dedicated email address (admin@st-annes-denton.tameside.sch.uk).
- c) Once you get the test results, please contact school via the dedicated email system.
- d) Emails will be checked daily (up to and including Thursday 27 May 2021)
- e) If we are told of a positive test (a pupil or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school) I will contact the bubble via parentmail or text.

It is the parent/ carer's responsibility to ensure that the child self- isolates for the period notified. Please be aware that we will only be responding to emails notifying of a Covid-19 positive case during the holidays. For all other queries, school will reopen as normal on Monday 7 June 2021.
