In response to parents/carers not receiving enough information about progress:

As a school we offer parents' evenings in October and March. When the reports go out in July we also give the opportunity to meet with the class teacher to discuss progress. If a child was struggling significantly, academically or socially, we would always meet with parents to discuss this and would not wait until a set time in the year. We also try hard to use social media to highlight what the children are doing in school and the curriculum and class pages can be found on our school website. Parents can make appointments to meet with teachers if they have a concern at any time during the year.

In response to the school running enough after school clubs/activities:

As a school we do try to offer a wide range of after school clubs. However, we are limited in terms of space and time! From September I am hoping to enlist the services of some private providers to enhance our offer. Information regarding these clubs will be sent via Parentmail once we have confirmation. We also hope to engage in more sporting events next year with the schools in the Victorious Trust and continue to attend those organised by the Tameside school sports partnership.
