We especially thank our Year 6 children, who are leaving, for their contribution to St Anne's and wish them all the best as they move on! In addition, our SATs results were once again **AMAZING!** We are again significantly above National for Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined at **80%**. We also achieved **83%** in Reading, **83%** in SPAG, **80%** in Maths and **90%** in Writing at the expected standards! All of these results are significantly higher than National figures. Well done to the children and staff for their effort and hard work!

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please remember when preparing for the new school year to ensure that your child's uniform conforms in both **type** and **colour** if you choose not to buy from our official suppliers (Kids Stop, Hyde). PE uniform is red shorts and white T shirt. **We also ask that children wear sensible school shoes and not trainers please!**

DINNERS FOR SEPTEMBER

All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will receive a free school meal. Dinner money is currently **£15.75 weekly (£3.15 per day)**. Payments are due in advance through Arbor. For all year groups, one week's notice is required to change from school dinners to packed lunches or vice versa.

TAMESIDE READING CHALLENGE

The summer reading challenge will once again take place and this year the theme is 'Read to the beat!' Please encourage your child to join in the challenge by reading six books over the holidays! You can sign up for the challenge in any Tameside library and certificates will be sent to school for all successful participants.

LOST PROPERTY

The lost property boxes are again overflowing. Unfortunately the majority of items in them are unnamed. It is important to ensure that your child's name is in all items of clothing and footwear. Please ask your child to check the lost property boxes in the infant and junior corridors for any items they have lost.

TRIAL CHANGE TO PE ARRANGEMENTS!

This September we are making some changes to how we arrange PE. In an attempt to ensure children get their full hours PE entitlement, they will come to school dressed in PE kit on their PE days. This will mean that your child wears full school uniform for 3 days each week and their PE kit for 2 days. PE kit is red shorts and white T shirt with black trainers and pumps. Please either buy the school branded kit or ensure that both the T-shirt and shorts are plain with no logos. In addition, for the colder days, children can wear plain black tracksuit/jogging bottoms with their school jumper. We will monitor this for the first term.

The days for PE lessons in September 2026 are as follows:

Reception	Monday and Wednesday
Year 1	Wednesday and Thursday
Year 2	Thursday and Friday
Year 3	Monday and Wednesday
Year 4	Wednesday Swimming and PE
Year 5	Thursday and Friday
Year 6	Tuesday and Thursday

We will inform you of any changes in PE days in advance.

Some children miss PE because they do not have their correct kit. This means that they are not accessing the full curriculum. We ask that all children come dressed in their **full school PE kit** on their PE day.

SCHOOL PREMISES

The school grounds are a smoke free zone and we also ask that parents/carers refrain from vaping. In addition we do not allow dogs on the premises at morning drop off and pick up. This extends to the gated area outside the playground. Thank you for your support in these matters.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

School closes for the summer break at **2.00pm** on **Thursday 23 July 2026**. It will re-open on **Thursday 3 September 2026 at 9:00am**. **The school gate will open from 8:45am**.
